

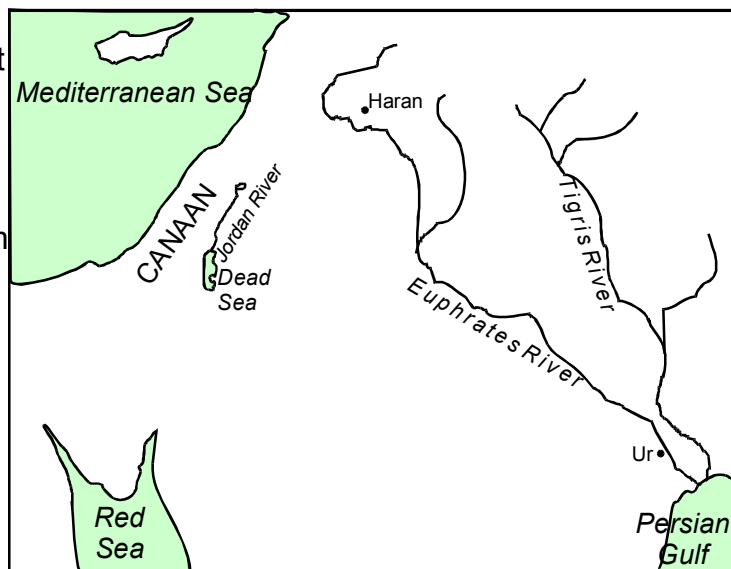
God's Promises to Abraham

1. Go outside on a starry night with someone who has a watch. Have them time you for one minute. Count as many stars as you can.
