

Sacrifice

Sacrifice is a word we don't use very much. It means to do something hard or give up something that means a lot to you. God wanted the Israelites to sacrifice an animal and offer it to Him when they did something wrong - to kind of make up for it.

God doesn't ask us to sacrifice animals any more. He wants us to give Him our whole lives and try to keep obeying Him.

There are still ways we end up "paying for it" when we do something wrong. Think of three ways you have had to make up for wrong things you did.
